

A Brief History

Established in 1857, Ottumwa Cemetery is the final resting place for many of our community's citizens and loved ones. Originally placed on the outskirts of town, it now sits as a park-like centerpiece to the town's Northside. Toward the end of the twentieth century, the Court Street entrance to the cemetery began to take shape and become what it is today, starting with the installation of the red brick receiving vault, continuing with the wrought iron fence and Ederly Gateway, and finishing with the limestone office and chapel.

Over the years, the City of Ottumwa acquired two additional cemeteries: Calvary Cemetery on Pennsylvania Avenue in 1953 and Ottumwa Jewish Cemetery on Van Ness Avenue in 2000.

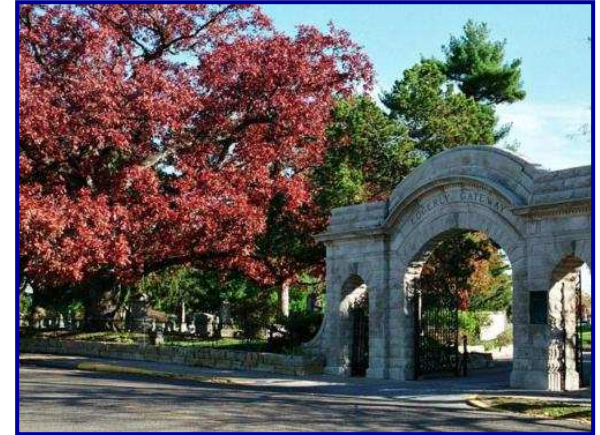

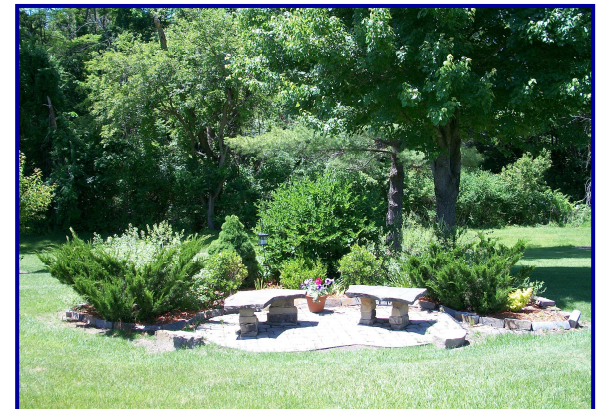
